Graduation Credit Requirements (1 credit = 1 year)

English - 4, Math - 3, Science - 3, Social Studies - 3,
Fine Arts - 1.5, PE - 1.5, Health - 0.5, Electives - 5.5

Minimum of 22 credits required for graduation of which 5.5 can be from elective courses.
